If in-home medical equipment depends on electricity, sign up for our medical alert list. Call 517-702-6006, or go to lbwl.com and click on Medical Alert Form.

Shut-off Protection

BWL customers at risk of shut-off are now eligible for Federal Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) and Michigan Energy Assistance Program (MEAP) funding assistance, and may also qualify for a winter protection payment plan. Seniors 65 and older and low income customers on a winter protection plan are protected from electric shut-off during the heating season. Additionally, active military customers may be eligible for extended payment arrangements to prevent service disruption. Contact 211 for payment assistance information, or the BWL to inquire about a payment plan.

Shifting away from fossil fuels is not only important for reducing carbon emissions, but also helpful in improving our community's overall health and wellbeing.

What are the benefits of going electric?

Depending on the type of switch you are looking to make, there are many ways electrification can improve your home or business environment and your health. For example, switching from a gas to an induction stove means removing the presence of gas in your home and improving your indoor air quality. - Electric Forklifts (Commerical): \$2,000 - \$4,000
- Electric Lawn Equipment (Residential and Commercial): \$25
 - \$150
