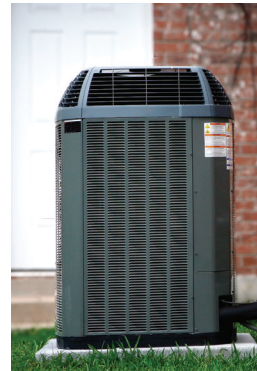

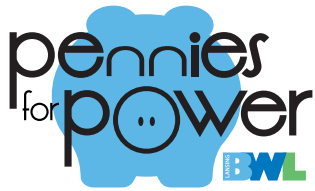

**BWL is Ready for Severe Weather Season**

As we head into severe weather season, the Lansing Board of Water & Light is always looking ahead to be prepared for any kind of emergency that comes to the greater Lansing region. Restoring your utilities quickly and safely is one of our top priorities.

In January, the Lansing region was forecasted for an ice storm that could have brought 1" of ice. The BWL declared a Mobilization Level 3, the highest level, which included placing the appropriate number of crews on standby and bringing in additional mutual aid line crews to Lansing.
